Why a Cookie Policy?

Your privacy is a priority for FOGES NV (also known as OFCORES, hereinafter referred to as "we" / "us"). In this respect, we are committed to protecting the personal data of visitors to our website (hereinafter referred to as "you") collected through cookies, tags, and tracers (collectively: "cookies"), and to processing them with the utmost care, in accordance with the applicable legal provisions — specifically the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the ePrivacy Directive (Directive 2002/58/EC), and the Belgian Electronic Communications Act of 13 June 2005.

1. Who Controls Your Personal Data?

The controller of your personal data is FOGES NV (OFCORES), having its registered office at Hendrik Placestraat 43A, B-1702 Dilbeek, Belgium, registered with the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under VAT number BE0799 416 689.

2. What Is a Cookie?

Cookies are small text files containing certain information that are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. They are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to any other website that recognises them. Cookies enable a website to recognise a user's device, remember preferences, and generally facilitate the user experience.

2.1. Cookies by Term of Validity

Persistent (permanent) cookies remain after a browser session is closed. They are stored on the user's device until they expire (if they have an expiration date) or until the user deletes them. Persistent cookies are typically used to collect identifying information such as browsing behaviour or user preferences for a specific website.

Session cookies last only for the duration of a visit to a website. They are automatically deleted when the user closes their browser.

2.2. Cookies by Origin

First-party cookies are set by the website you are visiting directly. The website has full control over the information collected via these cookies, and no data is sent to third parties.

Third-party cookies are linked to the activity of third-party partners. They originate from a website whose content is accessed indirectly — for example, via an embedded image, video, or advertising banner. Third-party cookies are subject to the privacy policies of those third parties.

3. What Cookies Do We Use and for What Purposes?

Cookies serve a variety of functions: enabling efficient navigation, remembering your preferences, measuring website performance, and enabling relevant advertising. When you visit our website, we use both essential and non-essential cookies.

You can find a full list of cookies, categorised by name, origin, purpose, and expiration date, in the cookie banner displayed on your first visit to our website.

3.1. Essential Cookies

These cookies are technically necessary for the normal functioning of our website. No consent is required to place essential cookies.

3.2. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies are used to provide services or features you have expressly requested, or to remember choices you have made to improve your experience. Your consent is not required for these cookies.

3.3. Analytical Cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use our website in order to improve its features and performance. Your prior consent is required before analytical cookies are placed.

5. How to Manage Cookie Preferences

Via our cookie banner

When you first visit our website, a cookie banner will appear asking for your consent before any non-essential cookies are placed. You can:

- Accept only necessary cookies — only essential and functional cookies are placed
- Customise your preferences — choose which categories to enable or disable

You can change or withdraw your consent at any time by clicking the Cookie Settings link in the footer of our website. Refusing a category of cookies will not delete cookies already placed in your browser; to delete those, use your browser settings (see below).
